WHAT: College Success Foundation's Empowering Youth luncheon supports students from across Washington state as they prepare for and graduate from college. CSF's programs are unique. We start early—beginning with middle school students—and support and guide them through college completion and beyond.

WHY: We serve underrepresented students who often face systemic barriers to accessing and navigating college. CSF Scholars include young people from low-income families, students of color, foster youth, and first-generation college students.

- 79% are the first in their families to attend college.
- 76% are from low-income families.
- 75% self-identify as students of color.

Proven Results: CSF Scholars finish high school, directly enroll in and graduate from college at higher rates than other low-income students.

- 97% of CSF scholars in Washington state graduate from high school.
- In 2022, CSF supported more than 20,000 students in middle school, high school and college.
- More than 12,000 CSF Scholars have graduated from college.

TABLE CAPTAIN GUIDE

HOW DO I SERVE AS A TABLE CAPTAIN?

Table captains fill a table with 8 guests by inviting 7 friends, family members or colleagues to join them for the College Success Foundation Empowering Youth luncheon on Thursday, October 19, 2023 at the Fisher Pavilion at Seattle Center. Table captains may also choose to co-captain a table by filling 4 seats at a table. You may select your co-captain, or we will partner you with another.

HOW DOES REGISTRATION WORK?

There are two options for guest reservations:

- As a table captain, you can choose to host guests with an advance reservation of \$800 for a table of 8 guests or \$400 for 4 guests if you are serving as co-captain.
- Or you can ask prospective guests to register individually by making their \$100 reservation donation online. All reservations are due by Monday, October 2, 2023.

WHAT TO EXPECT AS A TABLE CAPTAIN?

VIP status! Table captains are the direct link to the success of the event. We honor your time and commitment with:

- Personal service and support leading up to the event.
- Recognition as a table captain in the luncheon program.

We wish to provide you with information to make it as easy as possible to fill your table. We encourage you to connect with us personally if you need additional support.

INVITING YOUR GUESTS

Make a list of your prospective guests. Potential guests may include friends, family members, business or professional acquaintances. Think about the people you know through your social, recreational, professional or civic involvement.

Extend a personal invitation via email or over the phone to your prospective guests, and then mail the paper invitation as a follow-up. Add a personal note with your name and contact information on the invitations you mail. We suggest you "over invite" for your table, as there will be unanticipated cancellations. If all your guests confirm, we can set a table for 8 people. To send paper invites to your guests, contact Madeline Mulloy at empoweringyouth@collegesuccessfoundation.org.

Be confident and committed when you invite your guests. Share your personal reason about why you support the cause. Let them know this is a fundraiser occasion, informing them there is a \$100 reservation donation to attend unless you are hosting your table. If you are hosting your table, let them know they can choose to make a donation at the event.

RESERVATIONS ARE DUE OCTOBER 2, 2023

If you are hosting your table guests, please ask them to RSVP directly to you, and then provide your guest names and contact information to College Success Foundation–Tacoma by Monday, October 2, 2023.

If you are not hosting your table guests, be sure to ask your guests to reserve online at <u>collegesuccessfoundation.org/ey.</u> They will list you as their table captain and will make their \$100 reservation donation directly to CSF.

If you invite a guest who is unable to attend, please still send them an invitation with a note letting them know they will be missed. They may decide to make a donation to the College Success Foundation.
