He has dedicated his career to helping close the operational and cultural gap between STEM-related undergraduate and pre-college programs. His leadership and expertise has led to over \$100 million in grants and driven strategic partnerships to improve educational outcomes for diverse student populations. With this track record of impact, Dorsey is well positioned to take College Success Foundation to the next level and help thousands more students to graduate from college.
