- A person may not be eligible for federal aid due to:
 - Citizenship or immigration status, including being undocumented.
 - Defaulted federal student loans.
 - Repayments owed on federal grants.
- A person may choose not to apply for federal aid due to:
 - Family members who do not want to file the FAFSA.
 - Other personal reasons.

After you complete the WASFA, the college(s) or program(s) you choose will determine whether you meet [state residency requirements](#) and [state financial aid eligibility](#). A third party application servicer, Regent Education Inc., hosts the WASFA application for the state of Washington.

WSAC shares application information with campuses listed by the student so those schools may determine eligibility for resident tuition and financial aid. 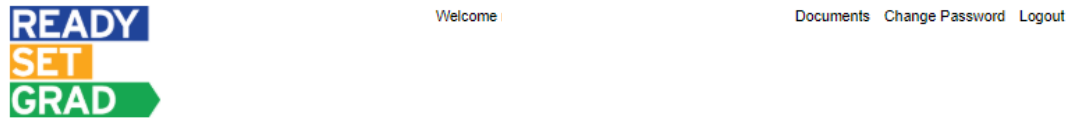
