By pairing in-depth student advising with financial assistance, we have created a scalable and effective model of success.



We prepare our students with the academic, financial, social and emotional support they need to be successful in life, beginning in middle school and continuing through high school, college and beyond.

College Success Foundation serves the underserved: those who might not otherwise get to college without our support. Our scholars include young people from low-income families, students of color, foster youth and first-generation college students.

We serve students in high-need areas where college graduation or enrollment rates are low. Our advisors work directly in public schools with high percentages of low-income students. We partner with schools and districts striving to improve high school graduation rates and increase the number of graduates going directly to college.

Colleges:

Over the past 21 years, CSF Scholars have attended colleges in every state of the nation.

FOR 20 YEARS, WE HAVE BEEN FOCUSED ON CLOSING THE ATTAINMENT GAP WITH THE UNDERSTANDING THAT EDUCATION HAS THE POWER TO TRANSFORM LIVES. WHILE WE SEE AND CHALLENGE SYSTEMIC INEQUITIES IN OUR WORK, WE KNOW WE HAVE NOT DONE ENOUGH TO DISMANTLE THEM.

WE ARE RE-EXAMINING OUR ROLE IN CHALLENGING PERVASIVE SYSTEMIC RACISM. IT IS NOT ENOUGH TO SIMPLY BE NONRACIST; WE HAVE IMPLEMENTED AN ANTIRACIST AGENDA. IBRAM X. KENDI DEFINES AN ANTIRACIST AS ONE WHO IS EXPRESSING AN ANTIRACIST IDEA OR SUPPORTING AN ANTIRACIST POLICY THROUGH THEIR ACTIONS. WE KNOW THAT WE CAN AND MUST PLAY AN ACTIVE ROLE IN OUR COMMUNITIES TO CHALLENGE AND DISMANTLE SYSTEMIC RACISM. THIS IS A LONG JOURNEY. WE RECOGNIZE THAT WE HAVE MADE AND WILL CONTINUE TO MAKE MISTAKES, BUT WE ARE COMMITTED TO LISTEN, LEARN AND DO BETTER.



CSF Scholars finish high school, directly enroll in and graduate from college at higher rates than other low-income students.

99% of CSF Scholars in Washington state graduate from high school vs. 87% of lowincome students who start their senior year in high school.¹

74% of CSF Scholars in Washington state who started college in fall 2019 persisted to fall 2020 vs. 68% of all students in Washington state regardless of family income.²

58% of CSF Scholars in Washington state graduate from college vs. 52% of low-income students who start college nationally.³

More than 11,600 CSF Scholars have graduated from college.

The pandemic continues to have a disproportionate, devastating impact on underserved students.



- Nationally in 2020, 49% of students who graduated from low-income high schools directly enrolled in college vs. 65% of students who graduated from higher-income high schools.¹
- There has been an ongoing decline in direct college enrollment, but the drop in 2020 has had a markedly severe impact on underserved students. While the direct college enrollment rate dropped 4% for students from low-poverty high schools, it dropped 10% for students from high-poverty high schools.²
- Overall, 600,000 (about 3.5%) fewer students were enrolled in college in spring 2021 compared to spring 2020. This decline was largest (about 9.5%) for community colleges where a significant share of low-income and first-generation students are served.³

Our COVID Response

We all remember our collective shock when COVID disrupted our world in March 2020. When public schools closed down across the nation, we shifted to an emergency response to minimize disruption to our scholars.

We responded in three immediate ways:

We shifted our model from primarily location-based services to fully-remote. We found computers, office equipment and other resources to support scores of program staff as they shifted to providing remote support.

We remained laser-focused on our CSF Scholars through the enormous academic, financial, social and emotional disruption. Our advisors went above and beyond in how they supported our scholars through these challenges by prioritizing the emotional well-being and basic needs of our scholars above all else.

We established the COVID-19 Student Support Fund to assist students and their families through this evolving and unprecedented situation. Thanks to the generosity of numerous donors, hundreds of thousands of dollars were raised. Funds were then distributed locally to our regions, allowing student advisors to immediately respond to the needs of their students. These needs ranged from accessing remote school instruction to keeping food on the table and addressing financial and medical emergencies.



As the devastating impacts of COVID continue to crystalize, we are doubling down with two major initiatives in 2022 and beyond:

- CSF's Rally for College initiative to support even more students in high school
- CSF's college services expansion to support even more students in college



Rally for College will support even more high school students.

The pandemic has disrupted the educational system unlike anything we've seen in our lifetimes. A challenge of this magnitude compels a bold and proportionate response.

College Success Foundation is proud to partner with Washington state and the Office of Superintendent of Public Instruction to create the *Rally for College* initiative.

We will leverage our existing relationships with the 28 public high schools we currently support to promote direct-to-college enrollment for all students in each school. Our CSF pathway model will be leveraged to serve even more students.

It will take a dramatic increase in resources to support this generation of students. We'll focus on what is needed most: providing college and career services to even more students and engaging more parents. We'll focus even more thoroughly on the transition from high school to college and tailor the supports to meet the needs of underserved students who stand to benefit the most.

It's a huge endeavor. But together, we can turn the tide for students and get them back on the road to college access and completion ... and brighter futures ahead.

We'll expand our college services to even more students.

When Rally for College gets underway in high schools, the next phase of our COVID response will grow and strengthen our college services program. Before COVID, CSF piloted and participated in a multi-year research study to determine the best practices of on-campus and virtual college advising.

We will leverage our research insights by adding numerous college advisors to our program. This expansion of services will simultaneously help CSF accomplish three critical things:

Serve more underserved students in college

Through our Rally for College initiative, CSF will be serving tens of thousands of additional high school students annually. Expanding our college services will ensure these students are prepared for their college journey.

Increase college enrollment

The transition between high school and college is a critical time for students as many withdraw from the process. Washington state's college enrollment rates have been declining for years and are at their lowest rate since 2016. Expanding our college advising program will provide a stronger support pathway for students transitioning to college.



Improve college completion rates

CSF's program is distinctive in that we employ college advisors to support students through their successful completion of college. Expanding this aspect of our program will help improve graduation rates and support more students in achieving their academic dreams.

Our intention to quickly expand our college services will not be easy. It will require new partnerships and collaboration agreements as well as significant financial resources.

We hope we can count on your support as we continue to battle COVID's impact on this generation of students. Our programs are unique. We start early—beginning with students in middle school—and support, inspire, and guide them through college completion and beyond.



Our advisors work directly in public schools with high percentages of low-income students. Advisors honor each student's lived experience by taking a holistic, trauma-informed approach that is tailored to the academic, emotional, financial and social needs of each scholar. We partner with schools and districts striving to improve high school graduation rates and increase the number of graduates going directly to college.

Grades 6-8

CSF's program begins in middle school when students' grades, attendance rates, and level of school engagement have a major impact on their ability to complete high school and be successful in college.

Our advisors are AmeriCorps members who work directly in the schools to create a collegegoing culture and build college and career awareness.

Grades 9-10

Our ninth- and tenth-grade program focuses on engaging students academically and guiding them on their path to college. Students get the support they need to successfully navigate the transition from middle school to high school, manage the academic rigor of high school, and become college-ready.

Advisors work full-time in schools and serve as coaches, advocates and mentors to students in the program. They ensure students have good academic behaviors, support development of academic mindsets, and equip students with the skills and knowledge they need to be college-ready.

Grades 11-12

Our eleventh- and twelfth-grade program provides the support and guidance students need to successfully navigate their last two years of high school and prepare for a successful college experience.

Located on high school campuses, advisors deepen students' understanding of college fit and match, support successful navigation of the college admissions process, and ensure students apply for and receive financial resources to pay for college.

College

College is a major milestone for students. It is a time when they move into a challenging new world of freedom, responsibility, new peers and unfamiliar surroundings. We continue to offer the customized support they need in college to help them succeed.




CSF Alumni


Destiny's story

College Success Foundation's Governors' Scholarship for Foster Youth has paved the way for more than 500 kids in foster care to attend college to date. I know this because I am one of the 500. In fact, I was part of one of the very first cohorts of Governors' Scholars in 2002 ...

... I'm constantly curious, passionate, and an "all in" person. I'm independent and have convictions. I'm not easily deterred, and I know what I bring to the table. If I were a penny, I'd like to think I'd be a shiny one. It wasn't always that way, though.

I was born to a teen mother and absent father. My mother was in full-blown addiction by the time I was 2, and the first time I was removed from her care I was 3. I was capable of getting myself to school by kindergarten, and that's when the world changed for me.

CSF's impact is amplified by partnering with schools, school districts, state agencies and other organizations committed to educational attainment. Knowing we are stronger together, we work to continually learn and share knowledge in order to harness the power of our networks.

Washington College Access Network (WCAN)

CSF staff lead the Washington College Access Network (WCAN) to raise awareness of the College Bound Scholarship and to increase FAFSA/WASFA completion rates. We provide training, tools, resources and technical assistance to school staff and communitybased practitioners tailored to fit each individual school, district and community.

We give counselors and school staff the tools and information they need to promote a college-going culture and provide their students with access to all financial aid opportunities.

WCAN is led in partnership with the Washington Student Achievement Council (WSAC).

Washington Passport Network

Washington Passport Network is a statewide collective impact initiative committed to supporting students from foster care, unaccompanied homeless youth, and the adult professionals they rely on. We provide information, knowledge and tools to improve practices and student outcomes.

If you are a professional who supports students from foster care or unaccompanied homeless youth in gaining access to, persisting within, or completing post-secondary education in Washington state, we consider you a member of the Washington Passport Network.

College Success Foundation staff lead the Washington Passport Network in partnership with the Washington Student Achievement Council (WSAC).



MENTOR Washington

MENTOR Washington is a public-private partnership founded in 2004 as a source of support for the hundreds of mentoring organizations across our state.

MENTOR Washington's mission is to promote, support, and expand quality mentoring that fosters positive youth development, academic success, and job and career readiness.

Scholarships have never been more critical for student success.


