What assets you should NOT report:

- Home where you and your family live
- Life insurance policies
- Retirement plans (i.e., 401(K), 403(b), pensions, etc.)
- 529 accounts with a beneficiary other than the student applicant and 529 accounts held by individuals other than the students and/or parent (i.e., if the holder is the grandparent, it should not be reported)

Note: Students will create an account and give consent. Electronic Signature requires typing name and last name on the application. Students who have access to at least one parent will have to invite a parent to sign the application electronically by adding the parent's email address in their applications. Parents will receive an invitation to complete and sign the form electronically.
