81% are the first in their families to attend college

67% are from low-income families

71% self-identify as students of color

CSF Scholars finish high school, directly enroll in and graduate from college at higher rates than other low-income students.

95% of CSF Scholars graduate from HS

74% of CSF Scholars persist into their 2nd year in college

63% of CSF Scholars directly attend college

59% of CSF Scholars graduate from college

We partner with schools and school districts with high percentages of low-income students to increase the number of students going directly to college. We partner with colleges and universities across Washington state to provide on-campus and remote coaching to improve persistence and graduation rates.
